## Synod 2021-22 Responses from Immaculate Conception Church, Kelowna, BC – Nelson Diocese

### 2. LISTENING

#### 2c What facilitates or inhibits our listening?

The Goal of listening should be to Seek Understanding. Some Facilitators to effective listening: Courage, transparency, compassion and charity are important. Being in relationship with people, developing trust and walking a mile with them is especially helpful. Having good faith formation and a deep relationship with Christ provide the tools for good discernment and prophetic listening.

Some Inhibitors to effective listening: Our own pride, ego, assumptions, biases, selfishness, mistrust, laziness to be involved with people who are different than we are. Our own wounds and past experiences of hurt can get in the way. Fear of the long-term time and energy commitment required can prevent people from entering into dialogue and listening to others. Cancel culture, woke culture and moral relativism inhibit listening, as well as basic skills of eye contact, attentiveness, and not interrupting. It is important to listen to all perspectives, check for understanding and clarification, and prevent ourselves from judging prematurely, filtering, jumping in with advice, or correcting.

#### 2e What space is there for the voice of minorities, especially people who experience poverty, marginalization, or social exclusion?

Some Christian charities like St Vincent de Paul reach out to the poor and Legion of Mary to those shut in. For most of us, often we don't know how to make space for or invite those who feel excluded. Perhaps we are too comfortable with our own lives to be bothered. Each of us has the potential to create that space for individuals, however as a community we can learn to work together, developing open doors so that all may enter, thus creating opportunities for us to confront our biases. Overall, when we don't make space to welcome, acknowledge or get to know the stories of others, their voices simply will never be heard.

On the other hand, there are some opportunities provided for connection and community, but commonly they are under-utilized due to some sort of barriers whether it be embarrassment, shame, fear, or past experiences of being brushed aside and needs not being met. Connection takes effort on both sides.

In addition, it is important for us to have Leaders who hold fast to the Truth while addressing the needs of others in the margins - not changing the rules to make people feel better but inviting them to true freedom in Jesus and His Church - Coming from a place of understanding and love.
