*Born on August 12, 1852, in Waterbury (Connecticut) of Irish  
immigrant parents and baptized there on August 19 in St. Peter's  
Church (predecessor to what is today the Basilica of the Immaculate  
Conception). **Ordained priest on December 22, 1877,** he was  
assigned to St. Mary's Church, New Haven, where his remarkable  
ability to relate to all people of every social, economic and religious  
background became apparent. **In 1882, he founded the Knights  
of Columbus,** a fraternal benevolent association that offered spiritual  
and apostolic direction to Catholic men. **He died of tuberculosis  
on August 14, 1890,** while Pastor of St. Thomas' Church in  
Thomaston (Connecticut) and was **beatified on October 31, 2020,**  
in Hartford (Connecticut).*

### WHAT DO CATHOLICS ACTUALLY BELIEVE?

Many people don't really know ... if this describes you or someone you know, **come and discover what our Catholic faith teaches** through the RCIA Program!

The "Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults" is a process through which non-baptized men and women enter the Catholic Church. The classes are also open to those who are missing some sacraments of initiation (eg: Confirmation) and include several stages marked by study, prayer, and rites at Mass. As a group, we journey together in a year of classes where we receive information and get our questions answered.

Taija from the 2022-23 class said this about her experience: "RCIA was a fantastic gateway into the mystery of our faith as Catholics. For those who want a starting point on getting to know the core values of Catholicism, whether baptised into the faith or not, I found this program to open up numerous doorways for learning and further conversion through group discussion, comradery and informative content."

## FALL 2023 PASTORAL CARE TRAINING SESSION

Through our Pastoral Care Ministry, volunteers visit the lonely, homebound, sick, injured, elderly, and dying, in hospitals, extended health care facilities, or at home. Lay pastoral care visitors can assist their pastors by helping to share Christ’s healing love and compassion with those in need—in their rawness and vulnerability—by offering friendship, encouragement, the ministry of presence, and, when requested, prayer, and Holy Communion.

The valuable and free Pastoral Care Outreach Training series will be offered online again this fall by the Diocese of Victoria Health Care Committee. Nine sessions will be held via Zoom on Saturday mornings from 9:30 – noon, **starting on September 23 and running until November 25, 2023** (with no session on October 7 for Thanksgiving). Participants who attend all sessions will receive a Certificate of Completion. Participants will require a phone number and email address, a computer, tablet or SmartPhone with speakers, microphone and webcam, a reliable Internet connection, and access to Zoom. Bishop Gary Gordon of the Diocese of Victoria feels “it is important to have parishioners trained at the ready to provide a caring and compassionate experience to those who are most in need.” Previous graduates have commented: “Loved every minute of it!
