Covid-19 Safety Plan

ACTION	PURPOSE & EXPLANATION
Waiver Requirement	Young adult participants and parents of youth will sign a waiver confirming that they understand the risks of participating in these events
Health Check Requirement	Upon arrival each time, participants will confirm that they are symptom free, have not travelled outside Canada, etc.
Closing the Parish Center	Parents will be asked to remain outdoors for drop off and pick up, and nobody other than the team and participants will be admitted to the Parish Center
Extra Sanitation Practices	Common touch surfaces will be sanitized before and after each event
Hand Sanitizing	Participants will sanitize hands upon arrival and after contacting common surfaces (eg, bathroom 'key')
Use of Face Masks	Participants will wear a mask when not distanced two meters (eg, upon arrival, when moving within the Parish Center) <i>Once a participant is at his/her designated spot, he/she may remove his/her mask while he/she remains at that spot</i>
Appropriate Spacing	Installation of a large screen to allow for spacing of participants throughout the hall One person will be allowed in the washroom at a time
Single Use Items	Reduce the need for hands-on materials by using digital means as much as possible (eg, digital examination of conscience)
Gathering Outdoors	Although the focus of the evenings will be on the sacraments, to provide some social contact for the participants, we will gather outdoors at the conclusion of each evening (rain or shine!)
Snacks outdoors and packaged	Single packaged snacks will be distributed by a volunteer wearing gloves Snacks will be consumed outdoors
