8. AUTHORITY AND PARTICIPATION

8c How are teamwork and co-responsibility put into practice?

At the diocese level and above, there appears to be little to no evidence of teamwork, encouragement or co-responsibility. There seems to be a lack of communication between levels of governance in our Church: between the Diocesan Office and parishes, between parish priests and parishioners.

On a parish level, there could be better dialogue between ministries to appear more cohesive and be more impactful - a liturgy committee comes to mind. Individuals in the parish are not being called out to use their gifts in the parish - if each person was involved in one ministry, the whole parish could be more unified in its mission, simply because everyone would be "known" by someone.

Our different ministries (eg. liturgical ministries such as lectors and musicians; Knights of Columbus and CWL, St. Vincent de Paul) seem to do a good job of working together and sharing the burden. However, it does seem that it is a small percentage of our church who are committed to these and other ministries resulting in burn-out.
