Are you *Called* to be a Permanent Deacon?

The deacon's ministry has three dimensions: *liturgy, word* and *service*. At the Mass, the deacon proclaims the Gospel, may be invited to preach the homily, and assists at the altar. In addition to their duties related to *service*, the deacon may also baptize, witness, and bless marriages, and preside at funeral liturgies outside of the Mass. Deacons may be married or single, they may have full-time careers or be retired.

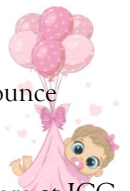

Haiti's CURRENT PULSE

A Special Letter to You from the HIMH Chair

Dear ICC Parishioners,

Earlier this month, *the U.N. Security Council authorized a multinational support mission to Haiti*. This authorization comes nearly a year later after Prime Minister Ariel Henry requested a special armed force to deal with the gangs in Haiti, who now control 80% of the capital city, Port au Prince. Haiti continues to face a humanitarian crisis for its nearly 12 million citizens. The cost of basic necessities (food, water, gas/diesel) remain double and triple from the prices previous to the September 2022 sea port blockade. Nearly 5 million Haitians face acute hunger, personal safety is often threatened, and daily living remains difficult.

Despite these challenges, our work to educate and nourish our children and their families in Haiti remains steadfast.

Our school opened as scheduled in September and our classrooms are almost at full capacity (some families live in areas still actively threatened by gang activity and are cautious to send their children at this time). Your student profiles are anticipated to be ready for Jan 2024.

As a global community, we have the resources to effect a positive change. We can ensure these children – Haiti's future – are not lost.

I encourage you to **open and read the full update** included in this bulletin email, our on display in the Parish Hall.

You bring hope, and you save lives.

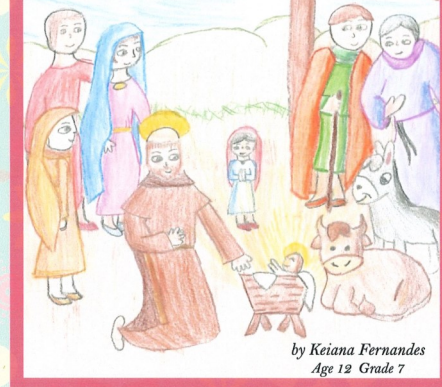
