
2022/23 MISSALS AVAILABLE

OFFERINGS FOR ICC

NEW ICC QR CODES ARE HERE!! You will notice that our pews now have a QR code attached (and posted here in our bulletin)! These have been used in other parishes with GREAT success to enhance donations and ease to parish giving. Here's the general process (each device is different...):



- 2. A yellow "Square Link" box will appear, touch that.
- 3. It will take you to an ICC site where you can donate. When requested, use "Sunday Collection" as the
- 4. reason for the donation. Follow the prompts (it should be relatively simple) and pay with your credit card.
- 5. When complete, you will get a text or an email to confirm your donation.

NOTE: Because you have to include your name and address during the process, you WILL get a tax receipt for your donation.

NOTE: This is an encrypted system and has been used with success AND privacy in numerous places before (including churches).

OTHER WAYS TO DONATE:

Pre-Authorized debit forms are available by email or mail if you are interested in signing up for donations through the SAG program. Email or call the office 250-762-3910 for more information.

Another way you can donate is to use an eTransfer from your online banking. All you have to do is create a new "payee" (eg. ICC Parish) and use the email etransfer.icc@nelsondiocese.org. In the message box indicate that you want your donation to go to Sunday Collection.

Regular offering envelopes will CONTINUE to be collected at Offertory at each mass. Extra envelopes will be available in the pews if you wish to use them, and still wish to donate with cheques or cash.

Are you *Called* to be a Permanent Deacon?

The deacon's ministry has three dimensions: *liturgy, word* and *service*. At the Mass, the deacon proclaims the Gospel, may be invited to preach the homily, and assists at the altar. In addition to his duties related to *service*, the deacon may also baptize, witness, and bless marriages, and preside at funeral liturgies outside of the Mass. Deacons may be married or single, they may have full-time careers or be retired.

The Deacon's Corner

Why we shouldn't Chit-chat in Church

Let's take a charitable look at the reasons behind the practice of being quiet in our churches, as it is important that we understand the "why" behind this discipline. As Catholics we keep our visiting (which we love) for the foyer; or better yet in the parish hall. Why? As a faith community we need to ensure that the main church remains quiet to allow for the necessary environment to prepare our hearts and minds for the Mass. But even outside of the Mass, we should do our best to keep this sacred space quiet to allow those present to enter and remain in prayer with the Lord.

Pope Francis recently spoke on the matter when he said: "When we go to Mass, maybe we arrive five minutes before, and we start to chit-chat with those in front of us. However, it is not a moment for chit-chat. It is a moment of silence for preparing ourselves for dialogue, a time for the heart to collect itself in order to prepare for the encounter with Jesus."

In the Gospel of Matthew, Jesus said "My house shall be a house of prayer." In other words, the Church is a sacred place set aside for people to come away {with the Lord} and rest a while from the hustle and bustle of our busy world. Our Heavenly Father made us, and He knows exactly what we need, even before we realize it ourselves!

Now that I said all that, let me add, we also need to be practical, for we are a 'faith community", if there is a need to speak within the Church, one simply needs to use prudence and courtesy, and speak in a reverent manner, as to not disturb our sisters and brothers who are praying or preparing themselves to celebrate the Sacred Mysteries.

For everything there is a season, and a time for every matter under heaven; a time to keep silence, and a time to speak. $^{\rm iv}$

Please help support our Christmas bake sale by donating baked goods!






