The Continental Stage of the Synod on Synodality
concluded on March 31, at which time the CCCB, along
with the United States Conference of Bishops (USCCB),
submitted the *North American Final Document for the
Continental Stage* to the Synod Secretariat.

The *Final Document* from North America, along with the
contributions of the six other Continental Assemblies, will
form the basis of the *Instrumentum Laboris* to be released by
the General Secretariat of the Synod in June 2023.

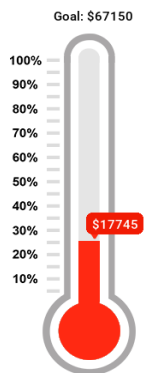
To date - \$17,745 — \$49,405 to go!
