## Synod 2021-22 Responses from Immaculate Conception Church, Kelowna, BC – Nelson Diocese Cont'd

#### 10. FORMING OURSELVES IN SYNODALITY

10a How does our church community form people to be more capable of "walking together," listening to one another, participating in mission, and engaging in dialogue?

Within the Church Community, sometimes Formation comes through "pop-up" faith/book study groups where those with a common need "walk together" and share their personal journey. As a Parish, formation in faith and virtues does not seem to be done in a formal organized way outside of Mass, unless there is a Parish Mission or day of reflection, but they are infrequent and aren't always well publicized or well attended. Mass and prayer as a community give us some of the skills and graces we need for participating in mission, but perhaps we stop short of learning how to serve each other well.

Personal formation for many comes through on-line conferences and platforms such as FORMED.org, Catholic YouTube speakers, Podcasts, DVD courses like "Unlocking the Mystery of the Bible" and others that allow for exploration of the rich history of Catholicism. Opportunity for involvement in various ministries, Marian processions, Pro-life initiatives, etc., enable us to "Walk together", however occasions to nurture fellowship are currently absent. Some individuals may follow up with the parish priest and unless they do, some materials they encountermay not be solid Catholic doctrine. Parish goals in this area may be to development classes/programs lead by facilitators on topics of faith and theology that would help form the laity - like continuing education at a college, but within the parish.
