## Synod 2021-22 Responses from Immaculate Conception Church, Kelowna, BC – Nelson Diocese

### 4. CELEBRATION

#### 4a How do prayer and liturgical celebration inspire and direct our 'journeying together'?

Prayer and liturgical celebration have the potential to inspire and direct our journeying together, but it doesn't always succeed. When we do it by rote without the involvement of the Holy Spirit, little can change in and around us. Reverent celebration of the mass nourishes and strengthens us. When we are drawn into worship so that we can encounter Christ, AND when we make efforts to grow in our understanding of the Mass and deepen our prayer lives at home, then we will be inspired. We need to be challenged often in our Mission to evangelize and offered tools to do so.

We can't be Christ for others if we don't know him. The more we immerse ourselves the easier it is to have faith, act justly and love another. Sharing our prayer and celebrations builds community, fellowship, and support for one another. They bring us together in front of God and we gain communal discernment - a single body on the same path to God. However, if the words are not truly spoken from the heart and the homilies are not relevant and meaningful our hearts may not be opened.

#### 4b How do they inspire the most important decisions?

Prayer and liturgical celebrations create a more Christocentric life that helps us put things in right order, trusting in God rather than attempting to control and manipulate things ourselves. When we tune in to the Holy Spirit, He will guide us in making important decisions. It helps when we see others in the community as examples of holiness, united in prayer and practice of the faith (sacraments). We need clergy who are truly humble (not all are!) and are seeking to grow in their own relationship with Jesus. When they are inspiring in their own joy and fervor, and live by example, the faithful in the community are properly shepherded. We want to Actually see Jesus in our clergy. We need to feel safe and respected. We need to feel valued.
