Today we celebrate the Solemnity of Pentecost, the birthday of the Holy Church and the end of the Season of Easter where for the last fifty days we reflected on the great triumph of our Lord Jesus Christ over sin and death. I certainly would like to take this opportunity to express my gratitude to all of you, my beloved brothers and sisters. Thank you for all your support for the past six years of my ministry as parish priest of our beloved Immaculate Conception Parish.

The past six years had been an experience of great providence from the Lord, even though we experienced the scourge of the pandemic, we surpassed all of it with a renewed faith in the Lord.

Please pray for me as I take on a new chapter in my ministry as pastor and as new Chancellor of our Diocese. Rest assured of my continued prayers and spiritual support to all of you.


ST. ANTHONY'S BREAD


