6b What particular issues in the Church and society do we need to pay more attention to?

As a Church, we need to have leadership that is united in true Catholic beliefs, and speak that Truth with boldness and love, never watering down for the sake of "tolerance". We do not need Division amongst Bishops and priests who have personal biases and beliefs. Public Scandals in the church need to be addressed appropriately and publicly some of these scandals come from the current Pope himself (e.g. not addressing scandal amongst public figures who claim to be Catholic and are doing things contrary to church teaching).

On the local level, we need to focus on building a sense of community, supporting new members, minority groups, and all families and helping them feel that the church is their home and that they can be involved. We need to pay attention to the youth, young adults, and put resources into different events in the parish and at the diocesan level. In Canada, the issue of "Truth and Reconciliation" still remains. The Church needs to do a better job informing society about what HAS already been done to reconcile the wrongdoings AND to point out the government not addressing the poor living conditions and rampant sickness of the residents when the issue was brought to their attention by the Residential Schools.


