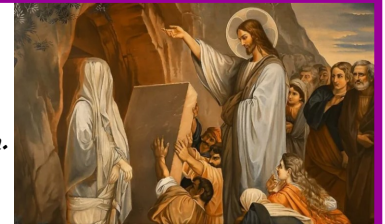

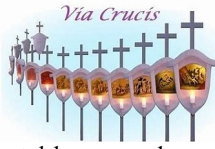

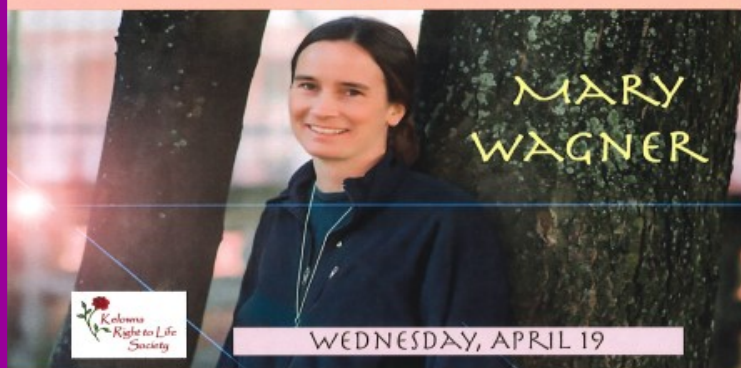

St. Vincent's Corner

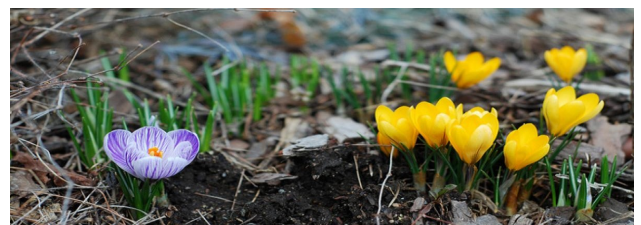
